

DSI Golf – New Payment Portal.

As those of you who bought books in Spain will know I have introduced a new payment system for yardage books that went online this week.

You can access this by typing **dsigolf.selz.com** in any web browser on your phone, ipad or laptop.

It is a simple system, you go to **menu/tournaments** and select the tournament you want to buy your book(s) for and click on the package you want. There are 4 choices Single Book Yards, Single Book Meters, Player Caddie Yards and Player Caddie Meters. Follow the prompts through the payment process.

You can choose one tournament and “buy it now” or add multiple tournaments to the shopping cart.

When you buy books a record goes into our system and a receipt is automatically sent by email. You retain this on your phone and use to claim your books at the event. A list of pre-ordered books will be with whoever is distributing on site.

We want to make this process as easy as possible and do not want to have any delays in you getting your books. Please buy your books if possible by the Friday before event week. This ensures complete lists on Mondays.

Why the change?

1. I am resident in the UK now and have registered the business in the UK with bank accounts, NI number limited company etc.
2. Taking so many cash sales leads to many problems in this set up. Eg collecting/transporting money and the accounts process. This had to change as many similar operations have changed in the last few years.
3. An increasing number of customers were arriving without money to buy their books and this meant an ever expanding debtors list which needed chasing up. The new system puts an end to that as **books will only be released on payment.**
4. You will notice that the payments are in pounds only. I am aware that this will add a small amount to the cost of the books for Euro card holders. To implement an online system initially it was too difficult (and expensive) to include a euro payment system. All of us that travel extensively have to pay for products and services in other currencies. This is no different.
5. Probably the cheapest way for Euro card holders to pay for books is to obtain a Pre load currency card in pounds. This saves on many of the card charges from mainstream credit and debit cards.
